Stop the clock!

on processing consents and LIMs

Resource consent and building consent applications submitted to us after 20 December may take longer than usual to process due to the Christmas/New Year break.

This is because the statutory processing clock stops over this period. In other words, the period between 20 December 2018 and 10 January 2019 is excluded from the 20 day working time-frame we're required to process consents within.

The statutory processing clock also means that LIM reports are excluded from processing between 25 December 2018 and 15 January 2019.
