	SUBJECT	MENACING DOG CLASSIFICATION - J CARMICHAEL

Council received 3 complaints from different complainants concerning two dogs residing at 14 Victoria Street Waihi, these complaints are dated 5 June 2007, 26 June 2007 and 13 July 2007 all relate to the dogs acting aggressively to members of the public, while walking on Victoria Street.

On June 26th 2007 as a result of complaints the dog 'Manny' was classified as menacing. Investigations revealed this dog was the principal offender and the second dog Chevy was present.

On the 13th July (3rd complaint) the other dog Chevy was classified menacing.

This was a result of the complainant walking past 14 Victoria Street with her children and their dog on a lead.

One brown/tan dog came from the driveway of number 14 barking and snarling.

The complainant stopped and the dog returned up the drive. As the complainant moved off, both dogs returned out onto the street barking and the complainant retreated across the street towards Edwards Transport.

The two dogs returned up the drive at 14 Victoria Street.

History:

Three complaints as detailed. Dogs in our District registered in January 2007 and the current year.

Manny – Brown female German Shepherd Cross neutered.

Chevy – Tan male Boxer Cross neutered.

Both dogs are now micro-chipped

Note: Appeal received outside the appeal time frame.

RECOMMENDATION

THAT the Menacing Dog Classification be upheld.
