



ASSESSMENT OF SANITARY SERVICES - PUBLIC TOILETS

Hauraki District Council is currently gathering information to undertake an assessment of water and sanitary services, including Public Toilets. One factor that needs to be taken into consideration is that some private toilets are considered 'publicly available', and your business has been identified as potentially one of these providers.

If Council accurately knows how many, and how often private toilets on commercial premises are used, this will ensure certainty when forecasting the number of public toilet facilities required throughout the District in the near future.

Once this material is collated the information will be used in the Assessment of Water and Sanitary Services Assessment. A draft of which will be available for public comment in April 2005.
