Roads and Trees

As we have reported before Council has been having problems with trees planted along roadsides, particularly across the Hauraki Plains, that damage the road surface by sucking out the water from under the road causing deterioration and deformation of the road surface. A report has now been compiled detailing those areas where trees are a problem and Council has approved the removal of all trees that have been identified in this report to have a high influence on the pavement. An annual programme is to be developed to remove the medium risk trees in the future as funding permits.

Meanwhile councillors have noted that the problem has not been confined to the Hauraki District. Those who travel regularly to Hamilton will have noticed recently that a row of trees has been removed along Waverley Rd (aptly named) after serious deformation in the last couple of summers. And how many people missed the turn off because they were aiming for the row of trees which is no longer there??!!

PUBLIC NOTICE

CLOSURE OF ROAD TO ORDINARY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

Pursuant to the Transport (Vehicular Traffic Road Closure) Regulations 1965, notice is hereby given that the Hauraki District Council, for the purpose of the annual Pipe Band Parade event organised by Positive Paeroa Inc., proposes to close the following road to ordinary vehicular traffic for the period indicated hereunder.

During the proposed period of closure the following provision will be made for ordinary vehicular traffic, which would otherwise use the road: divert to Station Road and Arney Street.

Any person objecting to the proposal is called upon to lodge notice of his objection and grounds thereof in writing before **4 January 2006** at the office of the Hauraki District Council at William Street, P.O. Box 17, PAEROA.

Road proposed to be closed to ordinary vehicular traffic:

Normanby Road between Arney Street and Wharf Street Paeroa, Belmont Road between Wharf Street and Marshall Street, and Willoughby Street between Hall and Arney Streets.

Period of proposed closure:

Saturday 11 February 2006 from 5:30pm to 6:30pm.
