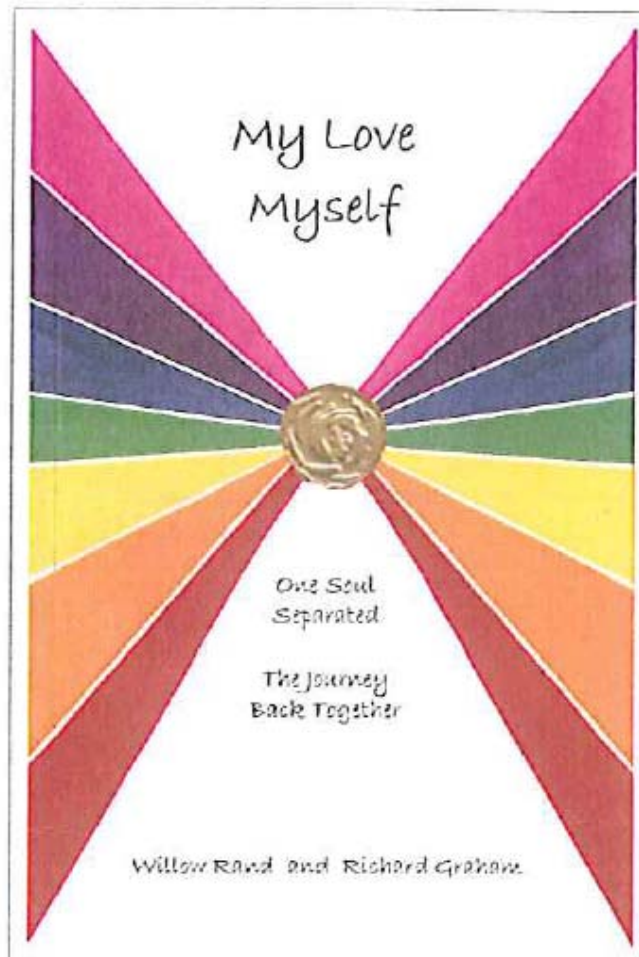


“My Love Myself” by Willow Rand, 2004.
