Eligibility

To be eligible for this Award:

- The nominee must be resident in the District at the time of service or achievement.
- The services for which the nominee is recommended must be related to activity within the Hauraki District, or activity directly benefiting the Hauraki District.
- Awards will not be made where nominees have been rewarded by payment of wages for services or achievement.
- Awards will not be presented posthumously.
- An Award may recognise outstanding long term service to a community organisation(s); or
- Any other activity or action which is considered worthy of award by the Council.

Awards will be granted:

- At a rate of six per fiscal year for service and no more than four per fiscal year for outstanding service.
- After presentation of a nomination by at least two nominators.
- After approval by the Council.

The decision of Council is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Awards will be presented at a special Council awards event.
