Survey of the Terrace stopbanks on the east side of the Piako River, between Kerepehi and Kopuarahi is being undertaken by Valley Civil Survey. The report is due by the end of February.

GENERAL BUSINESS**MEMBERS' COMMENTS**

The members were invited to comment on any general drainage issues of interest in their areas.

- Richard Webster queried the ownership of the Price Drain and Johnstone Drain stopbanks. There is some land in Waikato Regional Council ownership. The Drainage Manager will check this with WRC
- The credit in Area 4 Vegetation Control will be checked
- Keven Caddy noted that the Reservoir Canal weed is smelling badly. The Drainage Overseer noted that it needs a good flush with rain. The floodgate lifting chains have broken- this is a WRC maintenance matter
- The de-silting of the Awaiti Canal to improve the Reservoir floodgate action will be raised with WRC
- The issue with the stormwater works on Kerepehi Town Road has not been rectified. This is a matter for Council's roading contractor to remedy
- Some pump indicator lights appear to not be working. The Drainage Overseer will check and advise WRC
