Mechanical Cleaning

The North drain and its outlet into the Taramaire Stream were cleaned in June. The Taramaire outlet to the sea was completed in August.

Other works

Routine maintenance and inspections of floodgates and culverts has been undertaken and cleared as required. Weights were removed off the gates and the floodgates were desilted in June.

Pump Operation

The members were reminded that there are no pump stations located within this district.

Cleaning of the mouth of the Taramaire Stream

The Drainage Overseer advised the Chairman that he had been asked to clean the mouth of the stream by Clive Roberts.

The Chair asked for clarification on the process with which to register a land drainage issue with Council. He was advised that all requests will be dealt with by staff via Council's service request system.

The Chair advised that Bruce Levers has requested that a larger culvert be installed under his neighbour's access way to take water away from his own property due to flooding inundation from tidal movement. The Drainage Manager advised that the existing culvert meets the current level of service.

Adrian de Laborde attended the meeting at 9.50am.

Stephen Croymans stated he will speak with Bruce Levers and other landowners in the Taramaire District to seek their feedback regarding the request from Bruce Levers for a larger culvert installation at the location and report back on the outcome.
