On behalf of our Society, I am writing to request that our Waihi Ward Councillors consider assisting our Community Group to implement STAGE 1 of our Flowering Cherry Tree Program, at their next Meeting.


Trees, Stakes & Ties = 60 @ \$35 each = \$2,100.00
