Subject: Martha Project - Further information regarding NZ Transport Agency funding for local roads

Good afternoon Steve,

Following the commissioners request I have discussed the Transport Agency's funding of local roads within the Hauraki District with Rob Bullick, NZTA Principal Investment Advisor, who provided the following comment:

'Hauraki District Council's maintenance, operations and renewal budget submitted to NZTA is (in round figures) \$6.5m per year. NZTA contribute 60%, being \$3.9 million.... This does not include any improvement works.'

Mr Bullick was unable to provide a break down with regards to the funding of specific roads within the Hauraki District (being Baxter Road and Crean Road). Mr Bullick has suggested that Lukas De Haast, Hauraki District Council's Transportation Manager, may be able to provide further specifics on this matter.

I hope the above information will assist the commissioners in their assessment/decision.
