Busy thoroughfares and earthquake prone buildings

We're proposing to classify some of our streets as 'busy thoroughfares' under the national earthquake-prone building system.

That means unreinforced masonry buildings that are earthquake-prone and are located on those streets will need to be brought up to earthquake standards in half the timeframe as other buildings that are located in less busy areas in the District.

Decisions we make now could affect you or your family and/ or property so we'd like to know what you think.
