**DECISION**

***Introduction***

1. I have before me an application for the renewal of the on licence in respect of premises situated at 941 East Coast Road Kaiiua. The general nature of the business to be undertaken for the premises trading as Kaiiua Fisheries, is that of Restaurant/Takeaway. The hours sought are between Monday to Sunday from 10:00am until 09:00pm.
2. A report on the application was received from the District Licensing Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health, the Police and Fire.
3. The Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health, the Police and Fire do not oppose the application.
4. The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

***Committee's Decision and Reasons***

- There is no reason to believe that the amenity and good order of the locality would be reduced, to more than a minor extent, by the effects of the issue of the licence.
- There is no reason to believe that the applicant is not suitable to hold a liquor licence. There have been no enforcement actions at the premise that Council is aware of.
- There are no issues identified under sections 105 or 146 of the Act.

I am satisfied as to the matters which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of Act. Accordingly, I renew the applicants on licence.

I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.

No changes to the existing conditions are sought.
