DECISION

Introduction

1. I have before me an application by Hauraki RSA & Memorial Club Inc for the renewal of the club licence in respect of premises situated at 8 Pipiroa Road, Ngatea. The general nature of the business to be undertaken for the premises trading as Hauraki RSA & Memorial Club Inc, is that of a Members Club. The hours sought are:

Sunday to Tuesday 12.00noon to 8.00pm

Wednesday to Saturday - From 11.00am to 12.00 midnight

2. A report on the application was received from the District Licensing Inspector, Police and FENZ. The Medical Officer of Health did not report.
3. The Inspector, FENZ and the Police do not oppose the application.
4. The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

Committee's Decision and Reasons

1. There are no objections to the goods and/or services that the applicant is engaged in with relation to the principal activity of the business and there is no reason to believe that the applicant is not suitable to continue to hold a liquor licence.
2. The applicant has the appropriate systems, club officers, volunteers and training to comply with the law.
3. Council has not received any formal complaints with regard to excessive noise levels nor any other matter.

4. There is no evidence to suggest that the amenity and good order of the locality has been reduced to more than a minor extent by the effects of the existing licence.
5. I am satisfied as to the matters which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of Act. Accordingly, I renew the applicant's club licence.
6. I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.

Conditions

The trading hours applied for have changed from the previous Club Licence

When the duty manager is not physically on the premises only volunteers that have successfully completed the ServeWise host responsibility course shall serve at the bar.

Advice Note:

The club is aware that it is best practice to have a certified manager physically present when a larger crowd is in attendance, such as main club days or special events.
