DECISION

Introduction

1. I have before me an application by The Paeroa RSA & Citizens Club Inc for the renewal of the Club licence in respect of premises situated at 67-69 Belmont Road Paeroa. The general nature of the business to be undertaken for the premises trading as The Paeroa RSA & Citizens Club Inc, is that of a Members Club. **The hours sought are between Monday to Sunday from 10:00am until 12:00am (midnight).**
2. A report on the application was received from the District Licensing Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health and the Police.
3. The Inspector, Police and FENZ do not oppose the application.
4. MOH initially opposed the Application however that has now been withdrawn following information provided by the Inspector.
5. The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

Committee's Decision and Reasons

1. There is no objection to the goods and/or services that the applicant is engaged in with relation to the principal activity of the business.
2. There is no reason to believe that the Paeroa RSA and Citizens Club is not a suitable applicant to hold a liquor licence.
3. There is no reason to believe that the amenity and good order of the locality would be likely to be reduced, to more than a minor extent, by the effects of the issue of the licence.
4. The applicant appears to have appropriate systems, staff, and training to comply with the law.

5. No objections have been received following the public notification.
6. I am satisfied as to the matters which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of Act. Accordingly, I renew the applicant's club licence.
7. I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.

Conditions

- a) Alcohol may also be sold to a person who is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a reciprocal member.
- b) The lounge, games room and bar are **supervised designation**, the outside smoking area is **restricted designation**, the dining room is **undesignated**.
- c) On Friday nights, a manager must be on duty at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied.
