DECISION

Introduction

1. I have before me an application by The Sterling Waihi Ltd for the renewal of the on licence in respect of premises situated at 112 Seddon Street, Waihi. The general nature of the business to be undertaken for the premises trading as The Sterling Tavern, is that of a Family Restaurant & Bar. The hours sought are between Monday to Sunday from 7am until 1am the following day.
2. A report on the application was received from the District Licensing Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health, the Police and FENZ.
3. The Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health and the Police do not oppose the application.
4. FENZ objected on the grounds that the Evacuation Scheme has not been maintained through trial evacuations / training programme. However Council received an up to date report from FENZ dated 29/06/2023 with an Evacuation report.
5. The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

Committee's Decision and Reasons

1. There are no objections to the goods and/or services that the applicant is engaged in with relation to the principal activity of the business and there is no reason to believe that the applicant is not suitable to continue to hold a liquor licence.
2. The applicant has the appropriate systems, staff, and training to comply with the law. Certificated managers are employed at the licensed premises
3. There has been no reported nuisance, loitering, nor vandalism over the previous 12 months that could be attributed to the activities of the premises. There is no evidence to

suggest that the amenity and good order of the locality has been reduced to more than a minor extent by the effects of the existing licence.

4. I am satisfied as to the matters which I must have regard as set out in s.105 of the Act, and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the applicant an on licence.
5. I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.

Conditions

1. As of 1st November 2023 another manager will be required to ensure adequate coverage when operating at full capacity for the summer season.
