DECISION

Introduction

1. I have before me an application for the renewal of the on licence in respect of premises situated at 941 East Coast Road Kaiaua. The general nature of the business to be undertaken for the premises trading as **Kaiaua Fisheries 2025**, is that of Restaurant/Takeaway.
2. The hours sought are between Monday to Sunday from 10:00am until 09:00pm.
3. A report on the application was received from the District Licensing Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health, the Police and Fire.
4. The Inspector, the Medical Officer of Health, the Police and Fire do not oppose the application.
5. The application was duly advertised and did not attract any public objection.

Committee's Decision and Reasons

- There is no reason to believe that the amenity and good order of the locality would be reduced, to more than a minor extent, by the effects of the issue of the licence.
- There is no reason to believe that the applicant is not suitable to hold a liquor licence. There have been no enforcement actions at the premise that Council is aware of.
- There are no issues identified under sections 105 or 146 of the Act.

I am satisfied as to the matters which I must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and I am satisfied that the application meets the purpose and object of Act. Accordingly, I renew the applicants on licence.

I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.

Conditions

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not present on the premises to dine.
- b) Alcohol may be sold and supplied only while the premises are being operated as a restaurant, and only during the following days and hours:

Sunday to Monday 10.00am to 9.00pm.

- c) Drinking water must be freely available to customers from the point of sale.
- d) The host responsibility policy that was submitted with the application must be complied with.
- e) No intoxicated persons may be allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
- f) The licensee must ensure that an A4 sign stating the restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons is prominently displayed in two places so as to be easily read by people using the premises.
- g) The whole of the premises is designated as undesignated.
