

**IN THE MATTER** of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act  
2012

**IN THE MATTER** of an application by **Kelly Maree Fisher** pursuant to s. 138 of the Act for a Special Licence in respect of premises situated at **78 Orchard West Road Ngatea 3503**, known as **Ngatea War Memorial Hall**

**DECISION**

1. I have before me an application by **Kelly Maree Fisher** for a special licence in respect of premises situated at **78 Orchard West Road Ngatea 3503**.
2. The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the special licence. The Police offered no opposition to the granting of the special licence and the Medical Officer of Health have not reported on the application.
3. The application is for **Ngatea Primary School Fundraising quiz** on the **25<sup>th</sup> May 2024**. The hours sought are **5.30pm until 11.45pm**. The following conditions will apply to the licence:
  - Drinking water must be freely available.
  - Maria Ferguson will be available to provide a taxi service to patrons for a fee if required. (There are no commercial taxi operators located in Ngatea)
  - The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages and food appropriate to the occasion.
  - The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
    - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
    - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
4. I am satisfied that the nominated person will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol pursuant to the licence.
5. I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard in s.142 of the Act, and I am satisfied that this application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the special licence which may issue immediately.

6. I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.
