DECISION

1. I have before me an application by **Paeroa Pipe Bands Tattoo Committee Incorporated** for a special licence in respect of premises situated at King Street Paeroa 3600.
2. The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the special licence. The Police and the Medical Officer of Health have offered no opposition to the granting of the special licence.
3. The application is for Paeroa Pipe Bands Tattoo Committee Inc on the 10th February 2024. The hours sought are 11.00am until 9.00pm.
4. It is noted that the application was submitted on 8 January 2024 and payment received the following day. Allowing for the Christmas closedown period of 20 December to 15 January (inclusive) this leaves 17 working days prior to the event. Section 137 (1) of the Act sets out the timeframes required. (20 working days)
5. In this instance the agencies were able to report back to the DLC in time for the Inspector to provide a report for the committee to consider.
6. The applicant is advised to that any future applications need to be lodged in a timely manner to avoid a situation where a decision may not be handed down in time for the event.
7. The following conditions will apply to the licence:
 - Drinking water must be freely available
 - The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non - alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages and food appropriate to the occasion. Alternative forms of transport must be available.
 - The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
 - (iii) Ensure that event management plan is adhered to as described in the

application.

8. I am satisfied that the nominated persons will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol pursuant in accordance with section 213 (1).
9. I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard in s.142 of the Act, and I am satisfied that this application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the special licence which may issue immediately.
10. I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.
