**DECISION**

1. I have before me an application by Roderick Michael Hawkins for a special licence in respect of premises situated at 8559 State Highway 2 Waikino 3682.
2. The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the special licence. The Police and the Medical Officer of Health have offered no opposition to the granting of the special licence.
3. The application is for Art Waikino opening night and prizegiving on the 20<sup>th</sup> October 2023. The hours sought are 6.00pm until 9.00pm. The following conditions will apply to the licence:
  - drinking water must be freely available while the premises are open for business
  - The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages and food appropriate to the occasion. Alternative forms of transport must be available.
  - The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
    - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
    - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
4. I am satisfied that the nominated person will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol pursuant to the licence and as such I exempt the holder of the licence from the requirements of section 213 (1).
5. I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard in s.142 of the Act, and I am satisfied that this application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the special licence which may issue immediately.

6. I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.
