DECISION

1. I have before me an application by Kaiaua Boating Club Inc for a special licence in respect of premises situated at 1178 East Coast Road Kaiaua 2473.
2. The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the special licence. The Police and the Medical Officer of Health have offered no opposition to the granting of the special licence.
3. The application is for a series of 9 fishing competitions and social events on the days and hours listed below.

2023

- Saturday the 21st day of October 2023 from 1.00pm to 8:00pm
- Saturday the 18th day of November 2023 from 1.00pm to 8:00pm
- Saturday the 16th day of December 2023 from 1.00pm to 10.00pm

2024

- Saturday the 13th day of January 2024 from 1.00pm to 8.00pm
- Saturday the 3rd day of February 2024 from 1.00pm to 10.00pm
- Saturday the 16th day of March 2024 from 1.00pm to 10.00pm
- Saturday the 13th day of April 2024 from 1.00pm to 8.00pm
- Saturday the 11th day of May 2024 from 1.00pm to 8.00pm
- Saturday the 1st day of June 2024 from 1.00pm to 8.00pm

4. The following conditions will apply to the licence:
 - Drinking water must be freely available
 - The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages and food appropriate to the occasion. Alternative forms of transport must be available.
 - The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.

- (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
 - no alcohol is to be consumed within the vicinity of the known burial sites
5. I am satisfied that the nominated person will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol pursuant to the licence.
