DECISION

1. I have before me an application by Whiritoa Lifeguard Service Inc for a special licence in respect of premises situated at Kon Tiki Road Whiritoa 3646.
2. The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the special licence. The Police and the Medical Officer of Health have offered no opposition to the granting of the special licence.
3. The application is for 50th Anniversary of Whiritoa Lifeguard service on the Saturday 3rd February 2024 and Sunday 4th February 2024. The hours sought are 3.00pm until 12.00am(Midnight) on both days. The following conditions will apply to the licence:
 - Drinking Water must be freely available.
 - The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments and low alcoholic beverages and food appropriate to the occasion. Alternative forms of transport must be available.
 - The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the Premises.
 - (ii) Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and intoxicated persons adjacent to every point of sale.
3. I am satisfied that the nominated person will manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol pursuant to the licence.
4. I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard in s.142 of the Act, and I am satisfied that this application meets the purpose and object of the Act. Accordingly, I grant the special licence which may issue immediately.
5. I refer any party who wishes to appeal this decision or part of this decision to sections 154 through to 158 of the Act.
