1.0 Introduction

1.1 Purpose

The purpose of this bylaw is to set the rules for parking and control of traffic on any road in the district, other than State Highways controlled by Waka Kotahi New Zealand Transport Agency.

1.2 Title

This bylaw is the Hauraki District Council Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2022.

1.3 Enabling enactments

This bylaw is made under the Land Transport Act 1998. In addition, traffic and parking issues are also regulated and controlled by other enactments and regulations, including the Local Government Act 1974 and the Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004. These should be referred to in conjunction with this Bylaw.

1.4 Commencement

This bylaw comes into force on 1 September 2022.

1.5 Review

The review of this bylaw will be undertaken at the direction of the Council.

1.6 Related information

2.0 Definitions

Unless the context requires otherwise, the definitions of words or terms used in this bylaw that are also used in the Land Transport Act 1998 are those defined in that Act.

Authorised officer	means any person delegated, appointed or authorised in writing by the Council to act on its behalf.
Berm	means the grass area between the boundary of a property and the street; it can include both sides of the footpath, and includes any flower bed, ornamental verge, grass verge or plot, shrubbery or planted area which has been constructed as such.
Class of vehicle	class of vehicle means groupings of vehicles defined by reference to any common feature and includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none">a) vehicles by type, description, weight, size or dimension,b) vehicles carrying specified classes of load by the mass, size or nature of such loads,c) vehicles carrying no fewer or less than a specified number of occupants,d) vehicles used for specified purposes,e) vehicles driven by specified classes of persons,

	<p>f) carpool and shared vehicle, and</p> <p>g) vehicles displaying a permit authorised by the Hauraki District Council.</p>
Council	means the Hauraki District Council or any person delegated or authorised to act on its behalf.
Enforcement officer	means a constable, or a Police employee who is not a constable who is authorised for the purpose by the Commissioner, or a person who is appointed to that office by warrant under section 208 of the Land Transport Act 1998 or who holds that office by virtue of this Act.
Engine braking	means using the supplementary braking systems provided on heavy vehicles to assist the normal 'service brakes' in maintaining safe speeds travelling down hills.
Freight container	<p>means an article of transport equipment that is:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) of a permanent character and strong enough to be suitable for repeated use; and b) specifically designed to facilitate the transport of goods, by one or more modes of transport, without intermediate loading; and c) designed to be secured and readily handled having fittings for this purpose.
Heavy vehicle	means a motor vehicle (other than a motorcar that is not used, kept, or available for the carriage of passengers for hire or reward) having a gross vehicle mass exceeding 3500 kg, e.g. trucks, trailers, buses and heavy forklifts.
Network utility operator	has the same meaning given to it by section 166 of the Resource Management Act 1991 or subsequent legislation.
Parking place	has the same meaning as in section 591(6) of the Local Government Act 1974.
Parking warden	means a parking warden appointed under section 128D of the Land Transport Act 1998.
Passenger service and passenger service vehicle	have the same meaning as in section 2(1) of the Land Transport Act 1998.
Reserved parking place	Means any parking place which has been reserved by the Council for letting or allocation to any person or category of persons for reserved parking and which is clearly marked by a sign, notice or number or otherwise as being not available for public parking.
Road	<p>includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) a street; b) a motorway; c) a beach; and d) a place to which the public have access, whether as of right or not; and e) all bridges, culverts, ferries, and fords forming part of a road or street or motorway, or a place referred to in paragraph (d); and f) all sites at which vehicles may be weighed for the purposes of the Land Transport Act 1998 or any other enactment.

Road corridor	includes all parts of the legal road, including the carriageway, berm and footpath.
Traffic control device	includes any; sign, signal, or notice; or traffic calming device; or marking or road surface treatment; used on a road for the purpose of traffic control.

3.0 General

3.1 Resolutions made under this Bylaw

- a) The power to make a resolution under this Bylaw includes the power:
- i) to regulate, control or prohibit any matter or thing generally, or for any specific classes of case, or in a particular case, or
 - ii) that applies to all vehicles or traffic or to any specified class of vehicles or traffic, or
 - iii) that applies to any road or defined part of a road under the care, control, or management of the Council, or
 - iv) that applies at any specified time or period of time, or
 - v) to revoke, amend, replace or vary a resolution made under this Bylaw.
- b) In the event of any conflict between resolutions, the most recent resolution will prevail.
- c) Resolutions made under this Bylaw shall be recorded in attachments placed on the Council's website.
- d) Resolution-making powers under this Bylaw are additional to the Council's powers under the Local Government Act 1974 and other enactments and does not restrict those powers.

Resolutions need to meet the Local Government Act 2002 decision-making requirements. This means all reasonable options and their advantages, disadvantages need to be considered, as well as community views.

3.2 Road signs and markings

The Council may mark roads and/or construct signs on any road or part of a road, or any land owned or occupied by the Council, including any car park, public place, road, reserve, reserved parking place as necessary to give effect to any resolution made in accordance with this Bylaw.

For a complete list of our regulatory land transport signs and their locations, please see our website.

4.0 One-way roads

4.1

The Council may specify by resolution:

- a) that vehicles on roads must travel in one specified direction only;
- b) that cyclists may travel in the opposite direction on a one-way road.

4.2

Every driver of a vehicle must travel only in the direction specified on a one-way road.

5.0 Turning restrictions

5.1

The Council may by resolution prohibit:

- a) vehicles or classes of vehicles on any road from turning to the right or to the left or from proceeding in any other direction;
- b) vehicles turning from facing or travelling in one direction to facing or travelling in the opposite direction (performing a U-turn) on specified roads.

See Schedule 1 of this bylaw for one-way roads, and Schedule 2 for turning restrictions that are in place in the Hauraki District.

5.2

A person must not turn a vehicle to the left, or to the right, or perform a U-turn, or proceed in any other direction on any road where the Council has prohibited or restricted such movements.

6.0 Parking

6.1 Parking resolutions

The Council may by resolution:

- a) prohibit or restrict the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any car park, public place, road, reserve, reserved parking place or other places controlled by the Council; or
- b) limit the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on any car park, public place, road, reserve, reserved parking place or other places controlled by the Council to vehicles of any specified class or description; or
- c) prescribe the use of parking places including:
 - i. specifying the vehicles or classes of vehicles that may or may not use any parking place;
 - ii. prescribe the conditions under which any parking place may be used including the permitted duration and manner of use of the parking place;
 - iii. fix opening and closing times for off-street parking places;
 - iv. prescribe the times when vehicles may or may not use any parking place;
 - v. prescribe fees, whether annual, hourly or otherwise, for any parking space or parking place controlled by the Council, and may prescribe the methods of displaying appropriate receipts for payments, or other authority to use or park in such areas, and/or the methods of payment.

See Schedule 3 of this bylaw for parking restrictions that are in place in the Hauraki District.

6.2 Parking restrictions

- a) Except with the approval of the council, no person is to stop, stand, or park a vehicle on any car park, public place, road, reserve, reserved parking place or other places controlled by the Council in contravention of a prohibition, restriction or limitation imposed by the Council, and evidenced by appropriate signs and/or road markings, except for the purpose of loading or unloading goods or passengers at any property whose access is by way of the road or roads.
- b) No person shall stop, stand or park on an ornamental verge, lawn, garden or other cultivation adjacent to, or forming part of a road.

- c) Except with the approval of the Council, a person must not stop, stand or park a motor vehicle in the road reserve for any period exceeding 7 days if that vehicle cannot easily be moved on at the request of an authorised officer, or if it cannot be safely driven.
- d) If an authorised officer deems that a stationary motor vehicle poses an imminent safety risk to other road users, it must be moved immediately upon the request of the officer.

It is illegal to park a vehicle on a public road without a current license (rego) and a vehicle without a WOF is deemed unsafe to drive.

6.3 Machinery or equipment

A person must not park or place any scrap, machinery, equipment, materials, waste disposal bins or freight containers on any road, berm, road reserve or public place except with the permission of the Council and in accordance with any conditions that may be required. This clause does not apply to containers that are used solely for the purpose of kerbside collection of rubbish or recycling authorised by the Council and placed off the roadway, provided that such containers are not left on any road, berm, road reserve or public place for a period exceeding 48 hours.

6.4 Repairs on vehicles

A person must not carry out repairs or modifications to a vehicle on a road or road reserve unless those repairs or modifications are of a minor nature (duration less than 2 hours) and do not impede the flow of traffic or are necessary to enable the vehicle to be moved.

6.5 Parking for display or sale

Without the permission of the Council, a person must not stop, stand or park a vehicle on any road or parking place for the purpose of advertising a good or service, or for offering the vehicle for sale unless the vehicle is being used for day to day travel.

7.0 Traffic prohibitions

7.1 Restriction on driving on certain roads

- a) The Council may by resolution prohibit or restrict the use of roads as unsuitable for the use of any specified class of traffic or any specified class of motor vehicle due to their size or nature or the nature of the goods carried.
- b) The Council may by resolution prohibit, either conditionally or absolutely, the use of any road in a rural area by motor vehicles or by any specified class of motor vehicle for such period as the council considers necessary where it appears to the Council that owing to climatic conditions the continued use of the road may cause damage to it.
- c) A person must not use a road contrary to a prohibition or restriction made by the Council.
- d) If in the opinion of the Council it is safe to do so, the Council may permit a vehicle to use any road in contravention of a prohibition or restriction made under this clause for the purpose of:
 - i. loading or unloading goods or passengers at any property whose access is by way of the road; or
 - ii. providing an emergency service in or near a road from which it has been prohibited and for which alternative access is not available; or

The Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004 bans the riding of bikes on footpaths. The Police can fine people \$55.

- iii. undertaking maintenance on a road from which it has been prohibited and for which alternative access is not available; or
- iv. undertaking maintenance of a network utility provider's assets on or near a road from which it has been prohibited and for which alternative access is not available.

Refer to Schedule 4 of this bylaw for a list of restrictions on driving on certain roads.

7.2 Temporary restrictions on the use of roads

- a) Where an authorised officer considers that there is, or is likely to arise at any place on a road under the control of the Council, a temporary risk of:
 - i. Danger to the safety of the public or to a person working on or near the road; or
 - ii. Damage to the road;

the authorised officer may temporarily restrict the use of, or speed of, or class of vehicles which may use any part of that road.

- b) Any such restriction shall be defined by the display of temporary warning signs.
- c) For the avoidance of doubt, this clause does not limit any other powers the Council may have to close or restrict entry to any road.

The Council also has powers to temporarily close roads for events, maintenance and other reasons under schedule 10 of the Local Government Act 1974.

8.0 Engine braking

- a) The Council may by resolution prohibit or restrict engine braking on any road where the permanent speed limit does not exceed 70km/h.
- b) A person must not use engine braking on any road in contravention of a prohibition or restriction made by the Council.

9.0 Unformed legal roads

- a) The Council may by resolution restrict the use of motor vehicles on unformed legal roads for the purposes of protecting the environment, the road and adjoining land, and the safety of road users.
- b) A person must not use a motor vehicle on an unformed road contrary to a restriction made by the Council.

10.0 Weights of vehicles and loads over bridges and culverts

10.1

The Council may by resolution, either permanently or temporarily prohibit or restrict any specified class of vehicle from being driven on any specified road or part of a road (including any bridge, culvert, beach or other public place)

10.2

A person must not use a vehicle on any specified road or part of a road (including any bridge, culvert, beach or other public place) contrary to a restriction made by the Council.

11.0 Corridor access

11.1 Permission for corridor access

Any person carrying out an activity that:

- a) alters, or creates the need for alterations, to the surface of any part of the road corridor; or
- b) changes the everyday manner in which users (pedestrians, motorists, cyclists) would ordinarily use that section of road corridor; or
- c) consists of sustained or repetitive heavy vehicle activity outside the normal use of the road corridor;

must have corridor access permission from the Council, and may not carry out the activity without such permission.

11.2 Urgent corridor access

Where urgent works are required to protect the health and safety of the public or to protect or prevent damage to the road or a utility located within the road corridor, the person is not required to obtain a corridor access permit prior to carrying out the works, but must:

- a) notify the Council as soon as possible and within 24 hours of the situation arising;
- b) notify any utility operator whose utilities are likely to be affected as soon as practicable;
- c) where practicable, notify the owners of adjacent properties of the works being undertaken and the likely duration; and
- d) submit a retrospective application for a corridor access permit where requested to do so by an authorised officer.

11.3 Applications

An application for corridor access must:

- a) be made using the online application form available on the Council's website.
- b) include:
 - i. a traffic management plan;
 - ii. a plan of the works; and
 - iii. bill payer details for any applicable fee, and
 - iv. any other information required by the council to process the application.
- c) Where more than one party proposes work at a single work site, unless there is an agreement for one of the parties to take overall responsibility for the site (including maintenance), then each party must submit a separate application for corridor access, unless otherwise agreed by Council.

If your work is major, we suggest submitting your plan or design well before requesting corridor access. This will enable your corridor access application to be processed efficiently.

11.4 Timing of applications

An application for corridor access must be submitted:

- a) Minor works - for works that involve domestic service connections and/or works of up to 1m² that do not disrupt pedestrian or vehicular traffic: at least 5 working days before the work is intended to commence.
- b) Major works - for works that involve:
 - i. an excavation of greater than 1m²;
 - ii. a disruption to pedestrian or vehicular traffic;
 - iii. works with a duration of more than 10 days from establishment to final reinstatement; or
 - iv. multiple works;at least 15 working days before the work is intended to commence.
- c) Failure to comply with these timeframes may result in refusal of the application.

11.5 Permits

Permission for corridor access may be granted or refused at the discretion of the Council. The Council may, without limitation, have regard to the following criteria when making its decision:

- a) The safe and efficient flow of vehicular or pedestrian traffic;
- b) The health and safety of any person or class of persons who are likely to be affected by the proposed activity;
- c) The need to protect utilities, adjacent property or the road from damage;
- d) Any other works or maintenance being undertaken in the area that may be affected; and/or
- e) Any other matter that the Council considers relevant.

11.6 Permit Conditions

The Council may impose any conditions on a corridor access permit that it considers appropriate to address any of the matters described in 11.5, including, but not limited to:

- a) Compliance with information and plans submitted with the application;
- b) Protection of access to adjacent land;
- c) Requirements to reinstate or remedy any damage caused as a result of the activity;
- d) The timing of the activity or works;
- e) Co-ordination with or notice requirements to affected persons;
- f) The compensation that may be payable for property that is damaged as a result of the works or activity;
- g) Any insurance or qualifications that persons carrying out the works or activity must have;
- h) Signage, protective fencing or other devices required.

11.7 Non-compliance with permit

- a) Failure to carry out an activity in accordance with a corridor access permit, where one is required, is a breach of this Bylaw.
- b) The Council, through an authorised officer, may suspend or cancel a corridor access permit by giving notice to the permit holder if:
 - i. The permit holder fails to comply with the conditions of their permit.
 - ii. The permit holder fails to comply with the reasonable directions of an authorised officer necessary to avoid endangering the health and safety of any person or causing damage to any part of the road or adjacent land.
 - iii. The Council is required to by statutory or other legal obligations imposed on it.
- c) Notice under (b) may be given verbally and immediately where it is necessary to avoid imminent danger to any person, or where the permit holder has failed to comply with reasonable directions from an authorised officer.
- d) In all other circumstances, notice of the suspension or cancellation of a corridor access permit shall be provided by at least 48 hours' written notice.

If the vegetation is fenced in, it is the land owner's responsibility to maintain, even when on road reserve.

12.0 Vegetation

- a) No person is to dig up, remove or alter in any way the soil or surface of a road (including the road berm) without the authorisation of Council.
- b) No person is to plant trees or shrubs within the legal road boundaries of formed roads without the prior permission of the Council.
- c) Historical plantings established prior to the commencement of this bylaw may remain, provided the plantings are not considered to be a nuisance by the Council.
- d) The property owner or occupier is responsible for pruning and trimming vegetation from plants on property adjoining the road reserve (see Nuisance Bylaw).
- e) If any vegetation is permitted or allowed to encroach onto or over any public place so as to obstruct or interfere with the free movement of persons using that public place without the permission of the Council, the Council may by notice in writing require the owner of such building, structure, object or vegetation to remove the same or part thereof as specified in the notice.
- f) Council may require trees or hedges to be removed, lowered, or trimmed:
 - i. when work is required on the road to repair damage to the road as a result of trees on adjoining land,
 - ii. where overhanging vegetation is obstructing visibility at intersections or road corners or obstructing signs and street lights,
 - iii. it is of an age or condition that significant branches or the tree may fall onto the road corridor.

Willow and poplar trees can be particularly damaging to roads as they take a lot of moisture from the ground, causing cracking.

Hedges and shrubs should be trimmed to 2.5m above the footpath, and not encroach into the footpath space.

13.0 Hawkers and mobile trading

13.1

The Council may by resolution:

- a) prohibit or permit the occupation of stands or stalls (including vehicles used as stalls) by hawkers, pedlars, and keepers of mobile or travelling shops (subject, in the case of a state highway, to the prior consent of Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency and to any conditions imposed by Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency)—
 - i. in roads, public places, and state highways as the relevant road controlling authority thinks fit; or
 - ii. in specified roads or state highways or parts of specified roads or state highways; or
 - iii. in any public place adjoining specified roads or state highways or parts of specified roads or State highways if the presence of the stall or stand is likely to cause an obstruction or a danger to traffic.

Our Nuisance Bylaw requires you to have a 'hawkers' licence to sell goods in a reserve or other public place. See our website for the application form.

14.0 Offences and penalties

14.1

A person who fails to comply with this Bylaw commits an offence under the Land Transport Act 1998 and is liable to the penalties set out in that Act.

14.2

The Council may use its powers under the Land Transport Act 1998 to enforce this bylaw.

14.3

A person who fails to comply with this bylaw:

- a) may be served with an infringement notice in accordance with sections 128E and 139 of the Land Transport Act 1998;
- b) may have their vehicle moved if a parking warden believes that the vehicle causes:
 - i) an obstruction in the road or to any vehicle entrance to any property; or
 - ii) the removal of the vehicle is desirable in the interests of road safety or for the convenience or in the interests of the public.

The Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Regulations 1999 authorises the issue of an infringement notice for not complying with many of the restrictions imposed under this bylaw.

14.4

In addition to the powers conferred on it by any other enactment the Council may remove or cause to be removed from any road, or parking place any vehicle or thing using the road or parking place in breach of this bylaw.

15.0 Exceptions

15.1

A person is not in breach of this Bylaw if that person proves that the act or omission:

- a) took place in compliance with the directions of an enforcement officer, a parking warden or a traffic control device; or
- b) in the case of an act or omission done by an enforcement officer or a parking warden, was necessary in the execution of that person's duty.

15.2 Emergency vehicles

Restrictions made under this bylaw do not apply to:

- a) an emergency vehicle used at the time to save or protect life or health, or prevent injury or serious damage to property.
- b) medical practitioners such as doctors, district nurses and midwives who are attending an emergency.

15.3

Any restrictions made under clause 6 of this bylaw do not apply to a network utility operator or their authorised agent or contractor engaged in the provision of, or maintenance of a network utility operation;

15.4

Clause 7.1(b) does not apply to a road generally used by motor vehicles for business or commercial purposes or for the purpose of any public work.

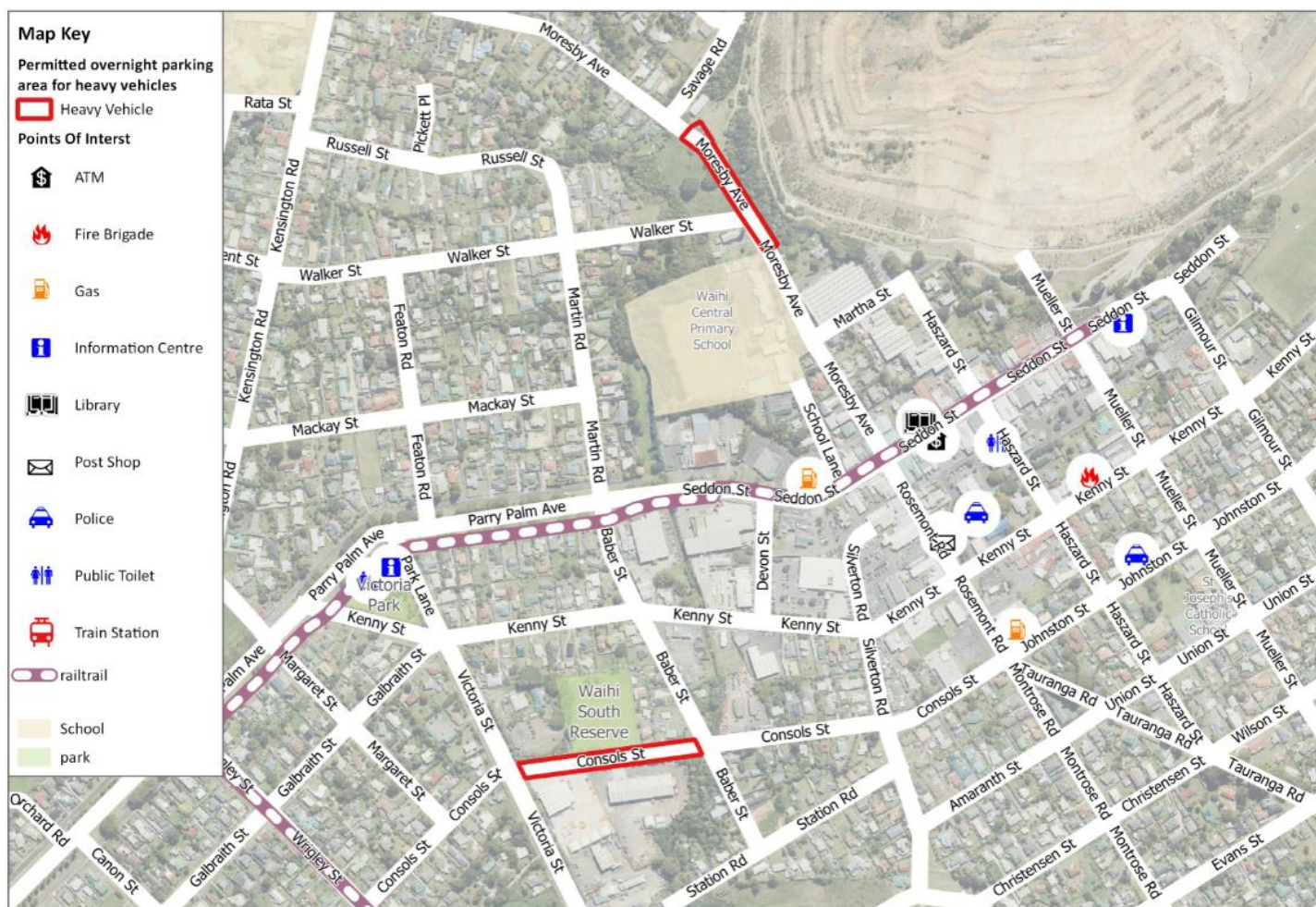

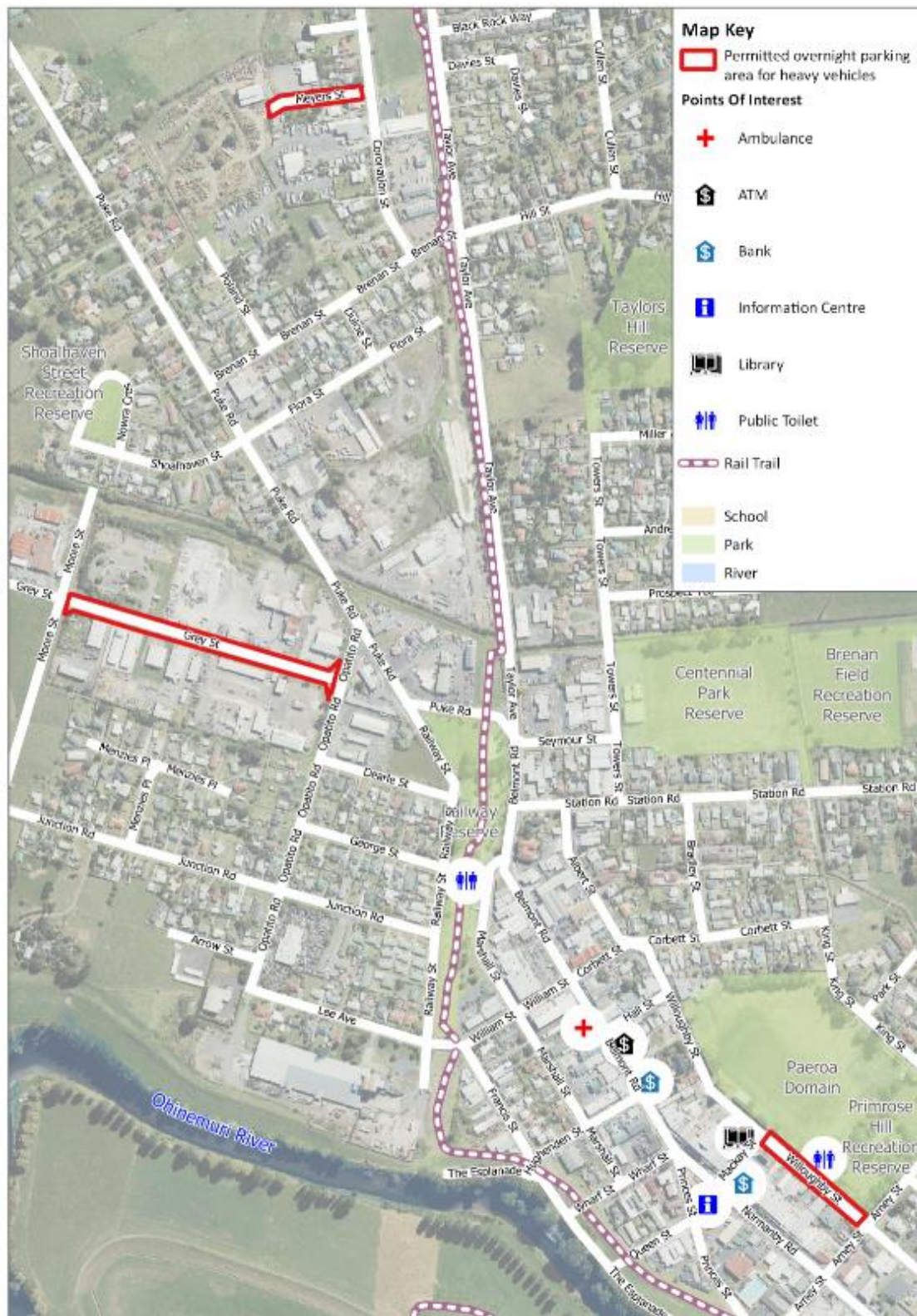

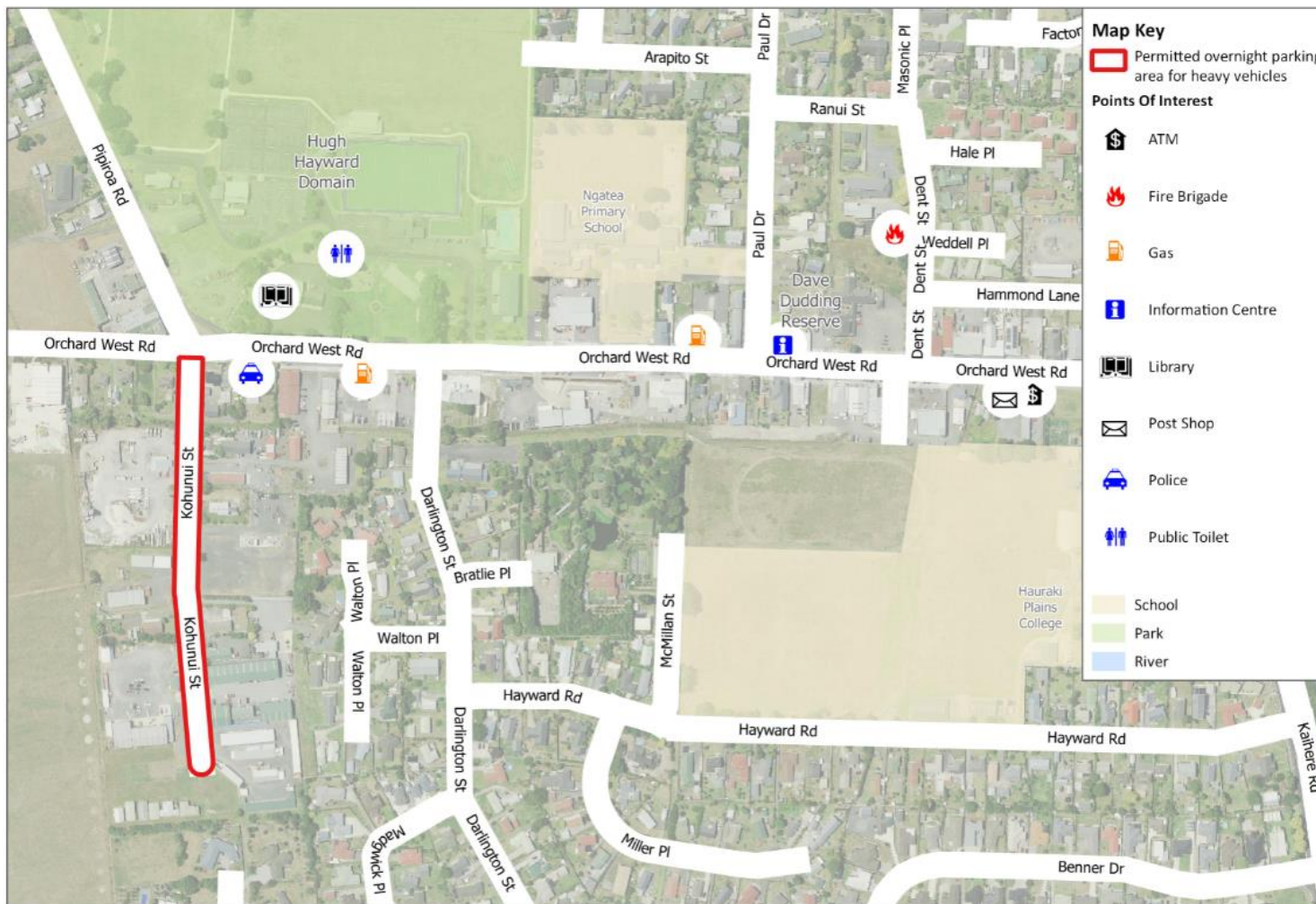
Waihi designated heavy vehicle overnight parking areas

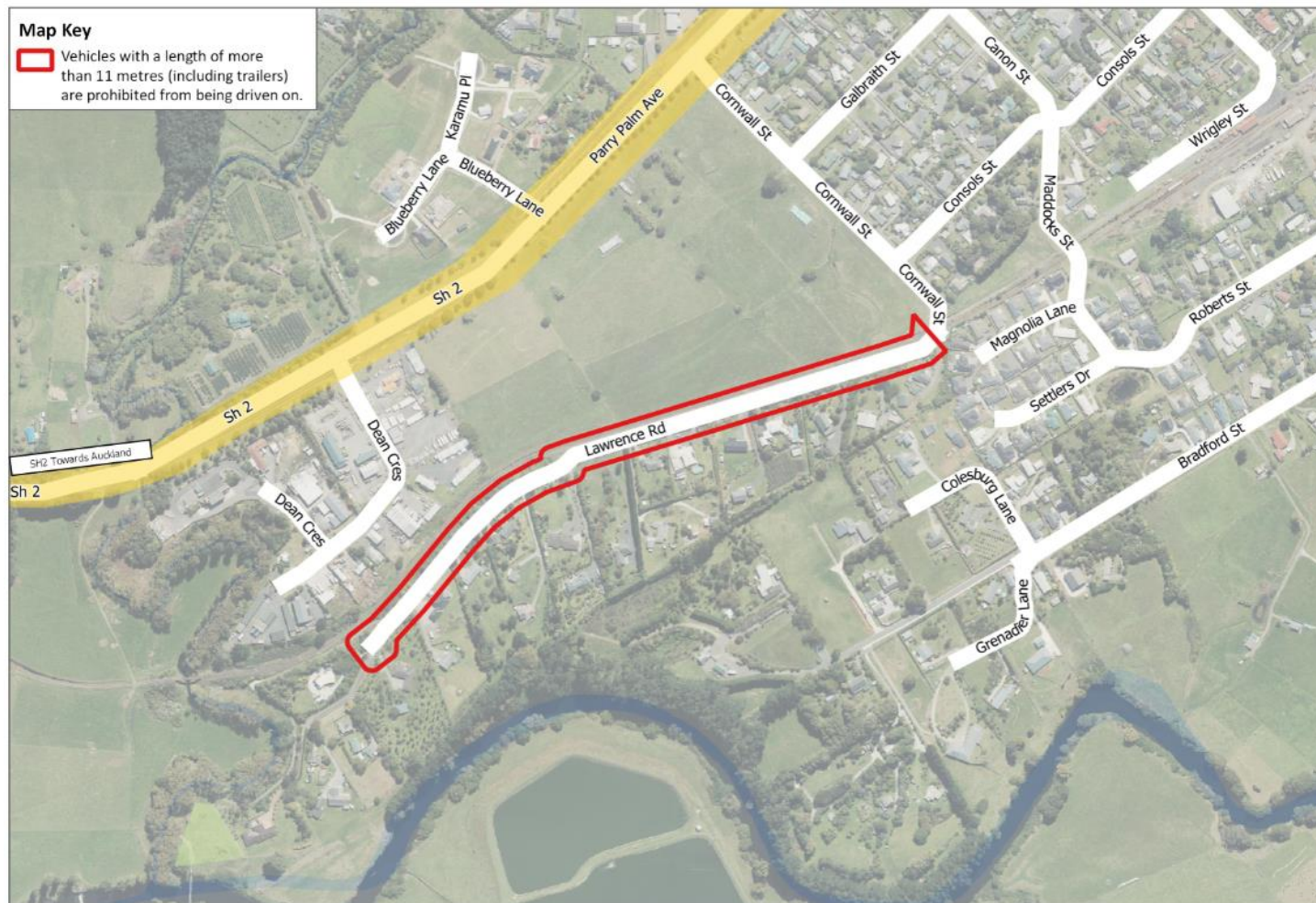

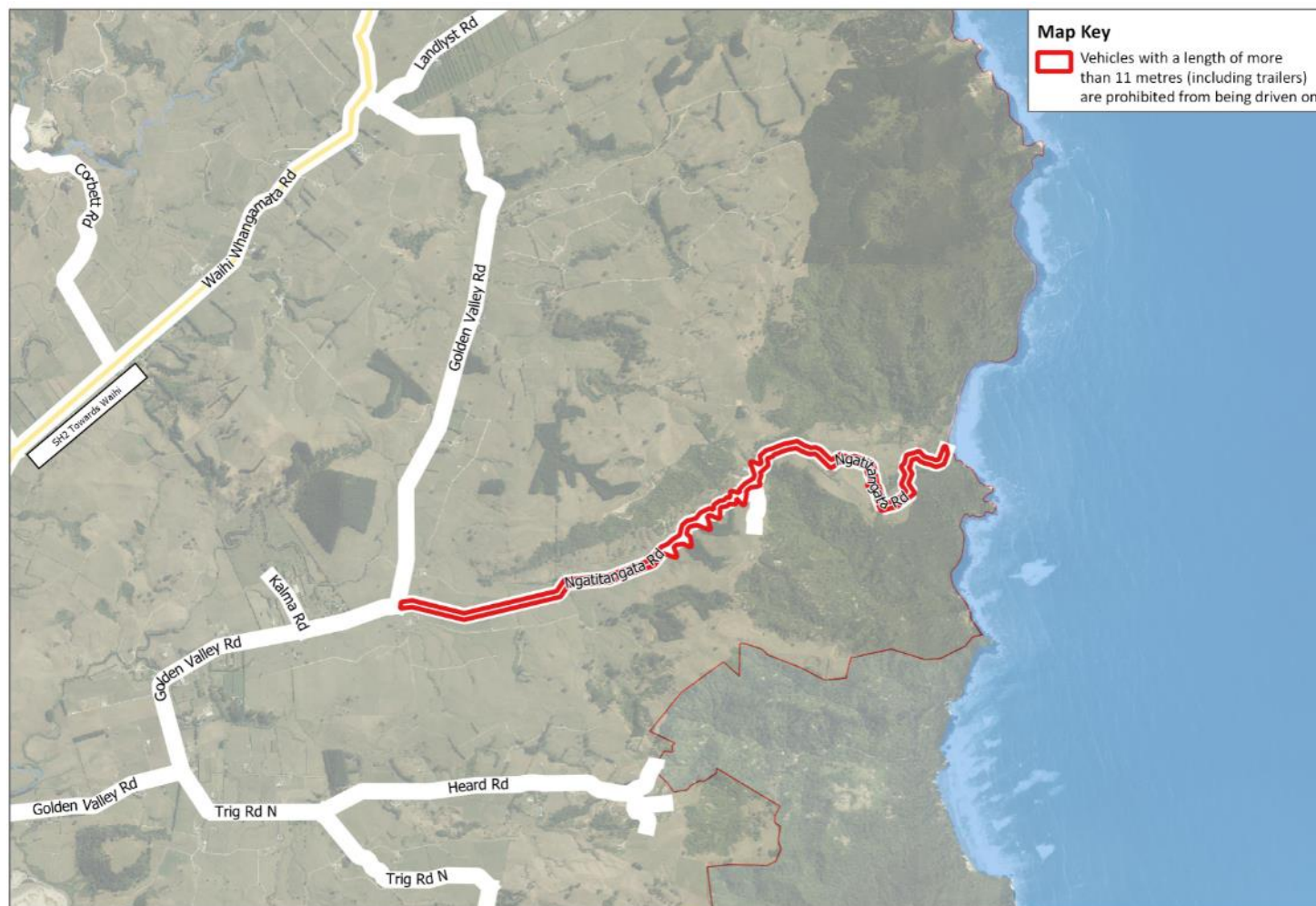

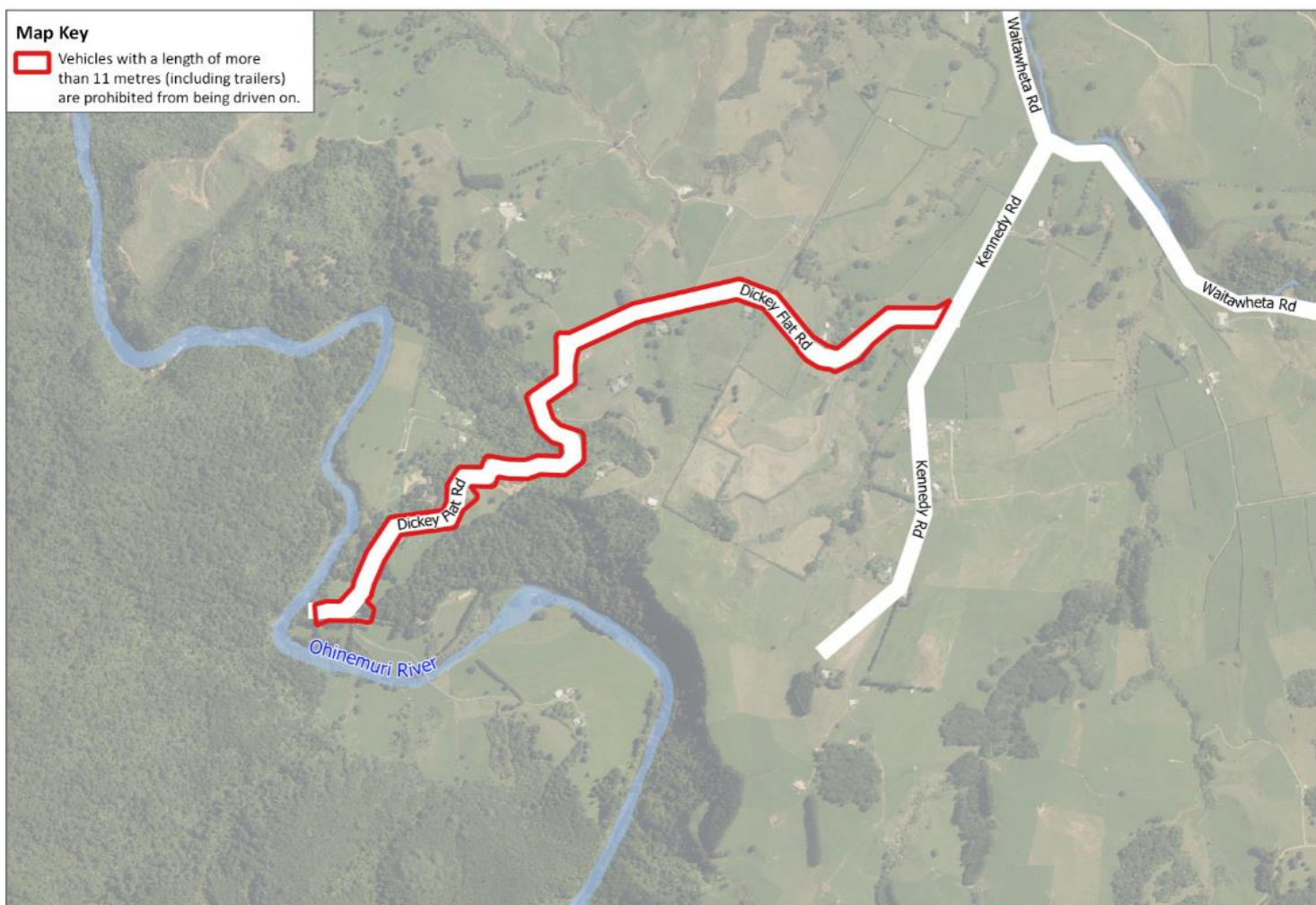
Waihi vehicle driving restrictions



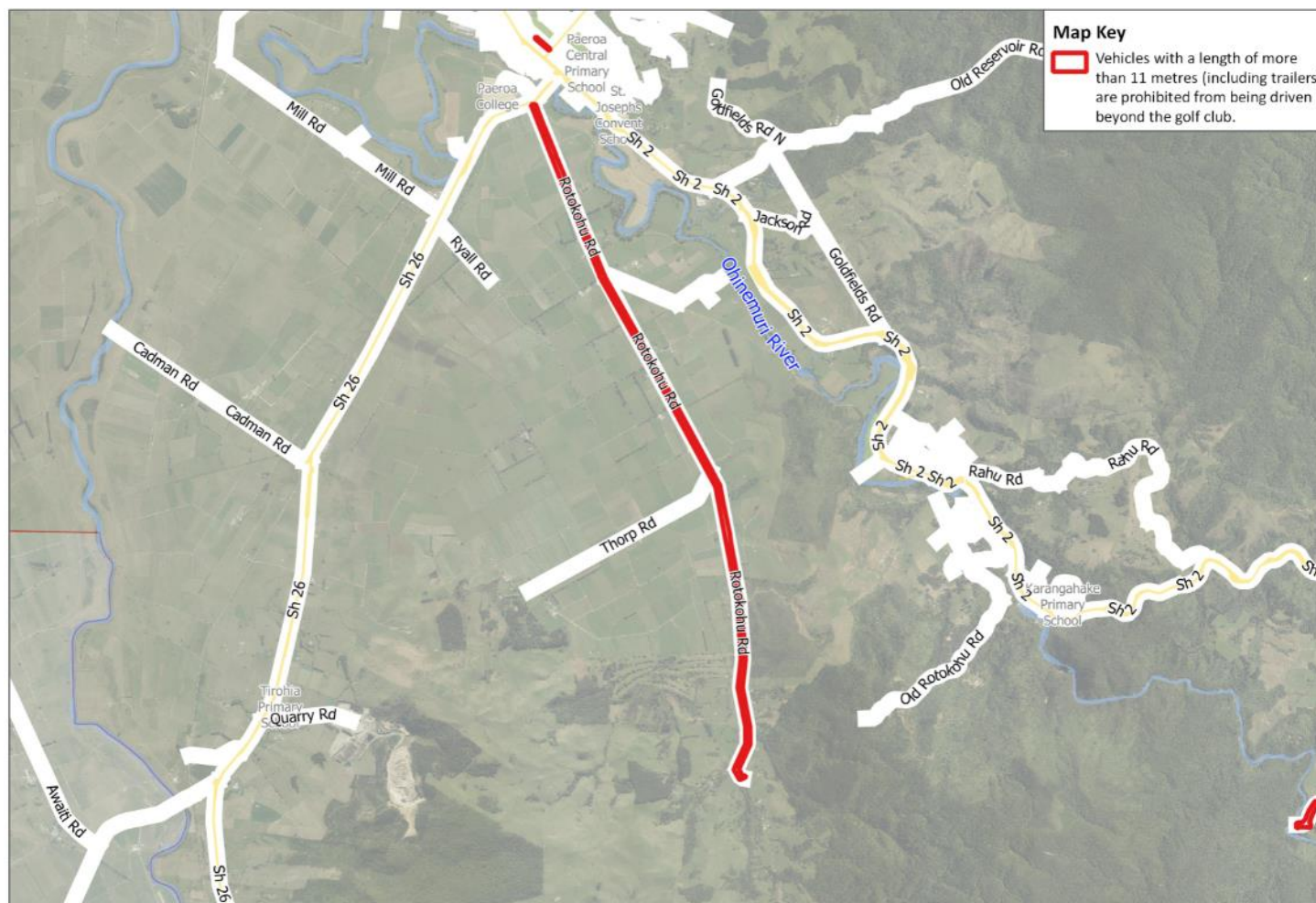
Waihi vehicle driving restrictions
