Physical Description: Two pyramidal stone cairns with basalt plaques featuring names of fallen soldiers from the district. Between them is a stone wall with additional memorial plaques. A ploughshare is placed on the stone wall.

The left cairn reads "Lest We Forget – This stone was erected in memory of Donald Anderson Ian Smallfield [and] Sydney Chapman/Sexton who fell in the second world war 1939-1945 and also in grateful recognition of all who served in this and all wars."

The right cairn reads, "Lest We Forget – This stone and pavilion were erected to the memory of Frederick Lincoln McIndoe and Henry Phillips who fell in the great war 1914-1918 and in grateful recognition of all who served."
