History: Previously the home of the AKRAD Radio Corporation. Keith Wrigley, the owner and founder, started off in this building making tricycles and radios. In 1932, Keith Wrigley opened a radio sales and repair shop in the A. J. Deans building. The nationwide demand for radios was such that he created the AKRAD Radio Corporation, AKRAD being short for 'Auckland Radio'. The company moved to new factory premises at Kings Hall in 1943.
