History: The Thames Valley Cooperative Dairy Company was formed in May 1901 following a meeting of dairymen and milk suppliers in the Wharf Street Hall. A. J. Thorp and A.C. Hubbard were elected as the first chairmen. They established a butter factory in Fraser Street by the end of 1901.

By the close of its first season, the factory had processed 94 tons of butter and had 67 suppliers on the books.

The growth of the company meant that new factories were required by 1914. However, the construction of a cheese factory at Waitoa in 1920 nearly bankrupted the company. The New Zealand Dairy Association allowed the Thames Valley Co-op and the Waikato Dairy Company to amalgamate with the Association. Wesley Spraggs, owner of the first failed creamery in Paeroa (1900), was allowed a second chance at management. The Paeroa branch of the new Association produced 1595 tons of butter and 2612 tons of cheese in its first year.
