History: The fire bell at the Paeroa Fire Station was originally from the Karangahake Fire Station. The Karangahake Fire Brigade was established in 1896 in a station in the centre of Karangahake. The fire bell was sited on a tower adjacent to the band rotunda. The tower was eventually dismantled and the bell moved to Paeroa along with the rotunda.

The Paeroa Fire Department was established on October 23rd 1895 under Captain Moore. The first fire station was located on Belmont Street next to the Ohinemuri County Council Chambers. The fire bell tower was located near the present Post Office location. The new fire station buildings opened in 1968, built by Walmsley Brothers. The fire bell was relocated to the new station and now stands outside the station. A centennial plaque was placed on the outer wall of the present station in 1995.
