Presbyterian churches formed a United Parish based in the Ngatea Methodist Church. In 1976, they joined with the Anglican Parochial District to form the Hauraki Plains Co-Operating Parish. The Ngatea Methodist Church Hall and the Presbyterian Sunday School Building from Turua were then annexed to the Anglican Church building in the centre of Ngatea in 1978. 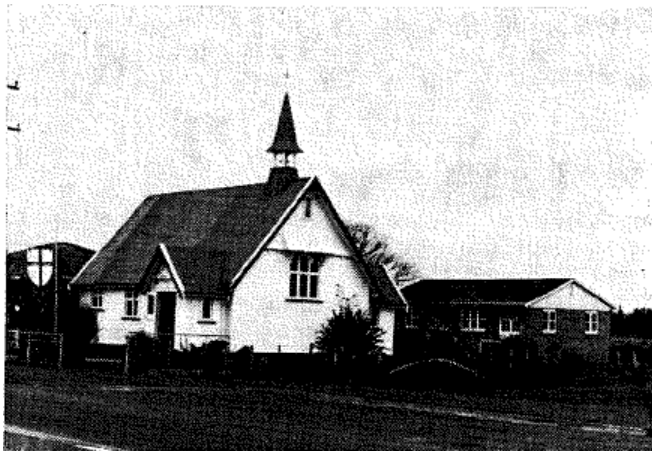
