So that food scraps can be turned into organic compost by Living Earth at Tirohia Energy Park, no bin liners (paper, plastic or compostable) are allowed in your bin. Food scraps only.

## YES



Egg shells and soft shells e.g. prawn shells



Fruit and vegetable stalks and peels



Meat, fish, small bones and cooled fat



Bread, pastries, cakes and biscuits



Coffee grounds and tea leaves (not tea bags)



Rice, grains, cereals and noodles



Left overs and plate scrapings, spoiled food and dairy products



Place bin at kerbside with handle in the upright, locked position.

Check our website or your handy flipchart guide for what can not go in the food scraps bin.

An ice-cream container is perfect for collecting food scraps and keeping them in the fridge or freezer until collection day or you can buy this cute kitchen counter caddy from us online for \$11.00.



## Hot offthepr ess

Yellow bags won't be collected at the kerbside in urban areas after 1 September 2023. Rural residents can order yellow bags online from us for disposal at the Refuse Transfer Stations.

Recycling bins still needing a RFID tag will be done during the first few weeks of the new service, as they are presented at kerbside for collection.
