3. CORE NAMING COMPLIANCE RULES (AS/NZS 4819 Standards)

Evaluate your chosen names against these standard regulatory requirements:

- **Three options provided:** List one preferred name and two viable alternative names per road.
- **No duplications:** Checked against regional database; name is not to be identical or similar sounding to existing streets within the local and surrounding districts.
- **Length limit:** Name is 15 characters or less (excluding the suffix/road type).
- **Easy to use:** Easy to spell, pronounce, and understand over emergency service radio lines.
- **Not offence:** The name is in good taste and carries no risk of causing public offense.
- **No commercials:** Free of commercial company names, brands, or trademarked entities.
- **Living persons:** Avoids naming after living or recently deceased individuals (unless exceptional historic criteria are met).
- **Appropriate suffix:** Suffix matches physical attributes (e.g., 'Cul-de-sac' = Close/Place; 'Wide thoroughfare' = Avenue/Boulevard).

4. CULTURAL AND LOCAL SIGNIFICANCE

- **Background/Origin Narrative:** Attached a short paragraph explaining the history, geographic features, or context behind each proposed name.
- **Thematic consistency:** Name aligns with any existing historical or developer themes used in surrounding stages of the subdivision.
- **Mana Whenua/Iwi engagement:** If utilising indigenous or Māori names, evidence of consultation and correct orthography (macrons) must be attached.
