CONDITIONS

- The discharge pipe and diffuser authorised by this consent shall be located and maintained in general accordance with the application for this resource consent and the document titled "Turua Wastewater Discharge Consent Renewal AEE", dated May 2002, prepared by Montgomery Watson Harza Limited, unless inconsistent with the activity authorised or the resource consent conditions below.
- 2. The consent holder shall ensure that the treatment plant is managed and operated by an appropriately trained operator.
- 3. The consent holder shall ensure contractors are made aware of the conditions of this resource consent and ensure compliance with those conditions.
- 4. The consent holder shall pay to the Waikato Regional Council any administrative charge fixed in accordance with section 36 of the Resource Management Act, 1991 or any charge prescribed in accordance with regulations made under section 360 of the Resource Management Act, 1991.
- 5. The discharge structure shall be maintained such that local scour is avoided.
- 6. The consent holder shall be responsible for the structural integrity and maintenance of the discharge structure and for any erosion control works that become necessary to preserve the integrity and stability of the river bed and channel and/or to control erosion as a result of the exercise of this consent. The consent holder shall undertake regular maintenance of the channel and shall keep a log of what maintenance has been undertaken. This log shall be made available to the Waikato Regional Council at all reasonable times.
